Auslan Community Classes

Deaf Australia provides courses in Auslan (Australian Sign Language). Auslan is the language of the Australian Deaf community. Sign language courses run for 8 weeks and will introduce students to basic communication skills with Deaf people and a general understanding of Deaf Culture.

Each session will run for 2 hours per week. Classes are very casual.

You will obtain a certificate of attendance after you have completed the course.

CLASS LOCATIONS

Classes are held at the Deaf Australia office at Stafford and various locations in Queensland.



Introduction to Auslan

This course is for anyone who wants to learn how to communicate with Deaf people. This basic level will include:

- ✓ Deaf Community and culture
- ✓ Fingerspelling
- ✓ Able to communicate to:
 - ✓ Introduce self and others
 - ✓ Basic expressions for meeting, greeting and farewelling
 - ✓ Basic information about self and ask basic information of others

Auslan 1

This program is for people who have done the introduction to Auslan classes and will give you the opportunity to build on your skills from the Introduction course. Students will be able to communicate to:

- ✓ Discuss personal background
- ✓ Topics such as
 - ✓ Occupation
 - ✓ Nationality
 - ✓ History
 - ✓ Favourite activities
 - ✓ Likes and Dislikes

Course Fees:
